What's changing and how to plan ahead

Attached is our working meeting calendar for 2019. This year, we are adopting an agile approach to event planning. With this approach, we'll be able to collaborate on the most timely issues in the format that best fits the unique needs of each stakeholder group.

"Agile planning?" What is this new approach anyway?

The core difference is that we're not planning an entire annual calendar of events all at once. Instead we are developing new events on a rolling basis, to ensure you have ample opportunity to tackle the timeliest issues with your Alliance network.

How many value visits will there be in 2019?

We are hosting four, three day value visits in 2019. We encourage every Alliance member organization to send delegates to ALL of these "anchor events."

How do I register to attend an event?

Visit the calendar on our website to view all upcoming value visit and value call details and register for events.

Why are some value visits listed on the print calendar not showing on the website?

We are adding value visits to the online calendar and turning on registration as soon as possible. Once an event's venue and dates are confirmed, you will see it listed on the calendar and registration will be open. We'll also email you when new events are added that match the interests selected in your profile.

Why are all the events in Dallas/Fort Worth, Texas this year?

This makes travel as convenient as possible for as many Alliance members as possible. DFW and Love Field airports are both easy to travel to/from, and Dallas/Fort Worth area hotel rates are favorable. Our goal is to keep member direct and indirect costs down. We're testing this in 2019 and will re-evaluate prior to 2020 event planning.

What exactly is a "fly-in"?

We plan on hosting nearly a dozen one-day workshops in 2019. The "fly-ins" are designed to have you out of the office for only 36 hours. These powerful events will focus tightly on hot issues and optimize learning and networking in a deep-dive format.

I don't see any events designed for my role! Does that mean there aren't any in-person events planned for my peer group?

Absolutely not! Our hope is at least one of the four value visits will be meaningful for every operational area.
